**Coladipietro Advances Sex Offender Immediate Notification Bill**

**Springfield ...** Citing the need to use 21<sup>st</sup> century methods to keep parents updated with the most current location of sex offenders, State Representative Franco Coladipietro (Bloomingtondale) sponsored legislation that would provide instant email alerts to parents with recent relocations of sex offenders.

“We need to protect our children from these predators of society.” Coladipietro said, “Parents today are extremely busy with everyday responsibilities of keeping their family and house running. These email alerts will make it easier for parents to keep on top of who is living and working in their neighborhood.”

Under current law, any individual can access thru the State Police website information based on zip code of where convicted sex offenders are currently residing. Under HB 42, the State Police would take their efforts further by providing on their website a form which can be filled out for email alerts. These alerts would notify that individual when a sex offender changes residence, employment, or school attendance to a location within a particular zip code or within a specified distance from an address.
