Coladipietro Announces Survey Results

Bloomingtondale ... With legislative leaders still working on producing a state budget, State Representative Franco Coladipietro (R-Bloomingtondale) today released his constituent's opinions on matters affecting the state. Representative Coladipietro sent a district-wide survey asking residents their views on issues ranging from the expansion of legalized gaming to healthcare coverage for every Illinois citizen.

"My constituent's opinions on matters affecting this state are extremely important to me, and I value every phone call, letter or email I receive. The survey was just one additional tool in reaching out and finding out how my constituents feel about specific state matters," Coladipietro said.

Coladipietro stated that over 900 responded to his survey and most individuals responding were grateful that an elected official had asked their input on state policy.

"As the budget impasse lengthens, these results are important in letting the Governor and legislative leaders know that overwhelmingly the residents of the 45th district will not stand for some of their policy initiatives including leasing the lottery – 78% against, increasing the income tax – 80% against, or providing universal healthcare – 67% against."
